RE: CHANGES IN REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

To Whom It May Concern:

This past legislative session, several new laws were passed which impact the registration of Sexual Offenders and Sexual Predators. The laws, most of which will go into effect this October, not only impact the registration process (i.e.: documents registrants must produce and information that will be collected), but requirements imposed on their daily lives (i.e.: operation of motor vehicles).

The Florida Action Committee is a non-profit organization involved in advocacy in matters relating to the registry. Among our members are registrants and their family members.

I am writing to request a comprehensive listing of the new or revised requirements that impact registrants so that we can distribute this information among our registrants. To our knowledge, registrants have not been notified of these new rules.
