Good afternoon,

I received your letter in regards to the hurricane/ emergency preparedness in relation to the sex offenders/ predators in Baker County. Please see the answers to your questions from attached letter below:

1. Registrants can evacuate to the Baker County Sheriff's Office where they will be directed to immediate shelter
2. There are no separate provisions
3. Please see number 1
4. Yes they will be separated, family members may seek shelter at the listed shelters throughout Baker County
5. Yes, registration will be open for compliance, however we are willing to be flexible in the event of a hurricane/ natural disaster. Should we need more man power on the front lines to assist citizens with emergencies/ evacuations, the hours would be more limited. Offenders/ predators will be updated on this information as information is received in order for them to be able to be in compliance
6. I am the program administrator for the FDLE registration station and will be the direct contact
