I received your letter in regards to the hurricane/ emergency preparedness in relation to the sex offenders/ predators in Baker County. Please see the answers to your questions from attached letter below:

- 1. Registrants can evacuate to the Baker County Sheriff's Office where they will be directed to immediate shelter
- 2. There are no separate provisions
- 3. Please see number 1
- 4. Yes they will be separated, family members may seek shelter at the listed shelters throughout Baker County
- 5. Yes, registration will be open for compliance, however we are willing to be flexible in the event of a hurricane/ natural disaster. Should we need more man power on the front lines to assist citizens with emergencies/ evacuations, the hours would be more limited. Offenders/ predators will be updated on this information as information is received in order for them to be able to be in compliance
- 6. I am the program administrator for the FDLE registration station and will be the direct contact
