Good Morning Ms. Colletta,

I received your letter in regards to Sex Offenders shelter requirements should a hurricane cause the area to be evacuated. I have answered your questions below:

1. Registrants can evacuate to the jail for housing.
2. Anyone registered regardless of probationary status, etc., can stay at the jail.
3. If someone needs to register, usually we would allow that unless there were extenuating circumstances such as a severe weather warning, tornado, etc.
4. They can contact the jail @904-548-4002 if they have questions during the storm.
5. If they do stay in our facility for shelter, they are allowed to leave if they choose to do so, we do not hold them.
