Registry requirements for out of state residents

- 1. 14 or more calendar days
- 2. Registrant will be added if they reach 30 calendar days.
- 3. The registrant will stay on the registry unless advised to be removed by the Attorney General's office. The registrant will be listed as being out of state once the return home.
- 4. The registrant is required to abide by the same rules, regulations and standards as their home state when visiting Delaware.
- 5. Tier III lifetime, Tier II 25 years, Tier I 15 years
- 6. We have three locations
