Dear Ms. Colletta,

I am in receipt of your letter dated 10-04-2019 and hope the information provided below is helpful.

- 1. Per Wisconsin State Statute 301.45, a registrant residing in Wisconsin must register with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Sex Offender Registry if in Wisconsin greater than 10 days. For short term visitation, the sex offender registry staff will discuss requirements to register if the person decides to reside in Wisconsin,
- 2. Yes, if residing in Wisconsin for more than 10 days.
- 3. The person is removed.
- 4. Residency restrictions are a function of local municipal ordinances and the registrant would need to contact local law enforcement to ensure they are in compliance with the local ordinance.
- 5. The Wisconsin Department of Corrections Sex Offender Registry does not currently have a tier system. Length of registration is outlined in Wisconsin state statute 301.45.
- 6. The registrant should contact the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Sex Offender Registry directly at 608-240-5830 during normal business hours and will be directed to a Wisconsin Department of Corrections Registration Specialist who will set up an appointment with the registrant.
- 7. Driver's License and address/employment information and any legal documents related to the registrant's conviction.
- 8. The registration process should take roughly one hour.
- 9. If the registrant registers with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Sex Offender Registry, there is a \$100.00 fee assessed each fiscal year.
- 10. Wisconsin State Statutes 301.45 and 301.46. The registrant can contact the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Sex Offender Registry with questions and/or information.
