Dear Ms. Bondi:

The Florida Action Committee is a non-profit organization that advocates for Public Safety. On behalf of our several hundred members, I am writing to find out what is being done to investigate those responsible for the fraudulent sex offender stings taking place in our state over the past several years.

Many of our members, who are serving a life-sentence on the sex offender registry, maintained they were never soliciting minors online. Instead, they were entrapped by law enforcement in an adult website through a bait-and-switch scheme and then railroaded into a plea upon threat of incarceration. Even those who fought back and were never charged or acquitted, were still publicly shamed and lost assets.
