RE: REQUIREMENT TO UPDATE TEMPORARY ADDRESS AT DHSMV

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing for guidance on the registration requirements for temporary addresses.

A member recently went to the local County Sheriff's office to register a *temporary* address, where he would be staying for 5 or more days. His *permanent* address remains unchanged, as he will be returning home following the brief visit.

He was advised by the registration office that in addition to registering the temporary address with the Sheriff, he would also need to go to the DHSMV (driver's license office) and update them with his temporary address there.

Please clarify whether an individual who is not vacating his permanent address, but visiting a location in Florida for five or more days is required to report to <u>both</u> the local sheriff's office and the DHSMV.
