Counsel,

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court wishes to advise the attorneys of record that oral argument in the cases scheduled to be heard during the week of June 9, 2020, in Miami, Florida, will not be conducted in person.

Instead, the Court offers two options for attorneys scheduled to argue those cases:

(1) Counsel may jointly move to submit the case on the briefs, with the motion due no later than Friday, May 29, 2020. If either party wishes to have oral argument the court will proceed with the argument.

(2) Counsel may participate in oral argument by audio conference from any location other than the courthouse.

The judges on the panel will conduct the oral argument proceedings and participate in them by audio. The usual order of arguments and time limits will apply.

Attorneys who are participating in an argument will be able to dial in by phone and enter an access code. The Clerk's Office, with the assistance of the Court's IT Department, will make the arrangements and notify counsel who will participate in the arguments of the necessary details.
