Your email of October 4, 2019, reached me this morning. I apologize for the delay in responding.

Please find attached a 2018 update to Ohio's SORN laws. This is the most recent update prepared by the Ohio Attorney General. Many of the answers to the questions posed by your letter can be found within it.
