RE: Requirement for Visiting Persons Required to Register as Sex Offenders

This letter is in response to your requests for information related to registrants traveling to (sojourning in, etc.) Oregon dated 7/27/20.

1.) "How many days (or hours) must a registrant be present in Oregon..."

Offenders must report when they move into the state, or are non-residents that work or attend higher education in Oregon have 10 days to report for registration in person, to the Department of State Police, a city police department or a county sheriff's office, in the county of the person's residence. Please refer to ORS 163A.020.

2.) "Will a registrant temporarily visiting Oregon be added to your state's public registry?"

No.

3.) "When a registrant temporarily visiting...leaves...continue to be listed as a registrant in Oregon?"

N/A.

4.) "Will a registrant temporarily visiting Oregon...residency restrictions...?"

Non-residents are not subject to residency restrictions under Oregon law.

5.) How long is registration required?

Registration is not required for temporary visits to Oregon. If offenders "move into" Oregon, registration is for life until relieved from reporting obligations.
