Emergency Evacuation Information

Plan Ahead & Evacuate Early!



What You Need To Know

If a disaster strikes, where should you go? How will you get there? Do you have a plan? The Pasco County Sheriff's Office and Pasco County Emergency Management have worked together to make sure you are know what to do. You need to know if you live in an evacuation zone and if so, which zone so you can take shelter at the right time and in the right place.

Location

Shelter will be provided at the Wiregrass Ranch High School to registered sex offenders. You **must** self-identify when you are on the school premises to avoid prosecution. Failure to selfidentify will result in a misdemeanour charge.

If you need to bring your family with you, they will stay in a separate area of the shelter. You will not be sheltered together during the evacuation.

What You Need to Bring

Be sure to pack these items and bring them with you:

• Food for 72 hours (Choose foods that don't need to be chilled or cooked.)

• Prescription medications in original bottles

- Sleeping bag, pillows, or blankets
- Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Important papers and keepsakes (driver's license, medical information, insurance policies, property lists, and photographs)
- Charger for cell phones and other mobile devices.

Items of Note

Alcohol is **not** permitted on school grounds.

Make plans now for your pet(s) to go to a safe place if you evacuate: arrange for a friend, family member or a boarding facility to keep your pet safe.

Please legally park your vehicle in the public parking area and check in with the shelter staff at the registration desk. Be ready to show identification once you arrive at the shelter, if requested.
