Commits a violation of s. 827.071(4) shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 15 YEARS imprisonment. Prohibits the solicitation of child pornography, as a third-degree felony; provides criteria to evidence actual or simulated lewd exhibition of the genitals of a minor for the purposes of classifying an image as child pornography.
