

## Notice to Sex Offenders Registering as Lacking a Fixed Residence

### Bureau of Detectives - Chicago Police Department

- According to the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act 730 ILCS 150/3, a *place of residence or temporary domicile* is any place where a sex offender stays for **3 or more days in one calendar year, even if not consecutive.**
  - **If you do not have a fixed residence, you must:**
    - Report in person every week
    - List all places you stayed in the past 7 days
  - **If you stay at one address more than two times, you must:**
    - Go to 9059 S Cottage Grove the day after the third stay
    - Register that address as your temporary or fixed residence
  - **If you stop staying at a listed address for more than 3 days, you must:**
    - Go to 9059 S Cottage Grove
    - Register again as lacking a fixed residence
    - Begin weekly check-ins at a location set by Criminal Registration
  - If you list the same address more than twice in a calendar year during weekly check-ins and do not register it officially:
    - **You will not be registered**
    - **You will be marked as non-compliant**

#### Additional Rules:

- **Per 730 ILCS 150/3, Child sex offenders cannot live or loiter within 500 feet of a school, playground, or daycare.** Any location you report will be checked for compliance. You can call Criminal Registration between 7am - 3pm to verify if an address is located within a prohibited zone. **312-840-7902 312-742-0101**
- When listing where you stayed, only include overnight stays (PM to AM). **If you work overnight hours, list the address you stayed during daylight hours.**
- **CTA buses and trains are for travel only.** Loitering is not allowed. Riding for more than **2 hours without getting off** is considered loitering and is prohibited.
- **All listed addresses are subject to verification checks by the Chicago Police Department (CPD).** Per 730 ILCS 150/3, CPD must verify at least **one address per year**, but can conduct as many as deemed necessary to ensure compliance.
- I am obligated to report to the Chicago Police Department **all current cell phone #s, email addresses, instant messaging or internet identities, URLs, blogs & internet sites maintained and to report any changes within 3 days.**
- **Giving false information is a crime:**
  - 1st offense: **Class 3 felony**
  - 2nd offense: **Class 2 felony**
