Director Glass,

The Florida Action Committee demands that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement immediately deindex the sex offender registry from all public search engines and remove unrestricted public access to the database.

The registry must be placed behind a secure access system that requires users to provide verifiable identifying information prior to entry. Access should be conditioned on acknowledgment that misuse of registry information; including harassment, intimidation, or acts of violence, is a criminal offense.

This demand is made in light of the recent Brevard County murder in which a registrant was targeted and killed using information obtained from Florida's public sex offender registry.

Now that you are aware the registry is being used to target listed individuals and their family members, we expect the FDLE to act immediately and institute these measures to protect the safety of *all* people in Florida.
